 sixth day of October in the Year of our Lord ~~1795~~
 Seven Hundred and Eighty four, Between James Parr
 of the County of Northumberland in the Commonwealth of

 Regiment in the Army of the United States of America
 of the one part; and Thomas Denton of the City of
 Philadelphia; Merchant of the other part; Witnesseth
 that the said Major James Parr for and in Consideration
 of the sum of two hundred and twenty five Pounds ~~in~~
^{in full settlement of certificates}
~~paid~~ to him in hand well and truly paid by the said
 Thomas Denton at or before the sealing and Delivery
 hereof, the Receipt whereof the said James Parr doth
 hereby acknowledge hath and by these presents doth
 grant, bargain, sell, release assign transfer
 confirm unto the said Thomas Denton his Heirs and
 Assigns, The full and Just Quantity of Six Hundred
 Acres of Land situate on the Waters of the Allegany
 River in that tract, part or Country situate in the
 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which was assigned
 and allotted by Act of the General Assembly of the
 said Commonwealth or State of Pennsylvania for the
 benefit and Advantage of the Officers and Soldiers of
 the Pennsylvania Line, and as a reward for their
 Services in the Army of the United States of America
 during the War with Great Britain; And the Reversion
 Remainders, Rents, Issues and Profits thereof, And also
 all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Possession, Property
 Claim and Demand whatsoever of him the said
