as I am entitled to in virtue of an act of the legislature
entitled "an act granting to Thomas Price a lot of do
nation land" passed the last session of the Legislature
and on having so drawn, thereupon to complete
the title to the lot of land in me by procuring a patent
in my name for the land so drawn according to Law
hereby giving unto my said attorney my full power
and authority to do all and every acts & things & things
in law for the obtaining a complete title for the said lot of
land to me as I myself might or could do were I personally
present and also if necessary an attorney under him
to substitute and appoint hereby ratifying confirming
and allowing all that my said attorney or his substitute
shall lawfully do in the premises. In witness whereof
