Whereas Patrick Donohoe Philip Kunkle James Burnside John Lawrey
Hugh Linds James Tragon Cornelius Higginson John Haskins James
Thomas James Higby Matthew Robinson John M. Quaid Thomas Sell
and Samuel Frankland Soldiers in the late Pennsylvania Regiment in the
Service of the United States by their several Letters of attorney under their
Respective hands and Seals duly executed bearing date the twenty seventh and
twenty ninth Day of November A sixth day of December 1794 the tenth and
seventeenth day of June the twenty third Twenty seventh and thirtieth
Day of July and the fifth Eleventh Eighteenth Twentieth fourth
Day of August 1795 did severally constitute and appoint the said
Henry Purdy their respective lawful ^{or office} Attorneys with full power
and Authority to appear at the proper office and receive in his own name and
for his own Benefit and use all such pay arrears of Pay Provisions Clothing
Lands or Depreciation Pay that might be due from the United States
or any particular State as in and by the said several Letters of Attorney
Now remaining in the Secretarys Office at Philadelphia Relation

Thereunto hath appeared Now know ye that the said Henry Purdy
by force and Virtue of the said several Letters of Attorney and force of
Substitution therein Respectfully contained and by every other way
Means rights and forms by which it may more effectually and Lawfully
be done hath Substituted and in his place and stead put and deputed
and by these presents doth Substitute and in his place and stead put and
depute Michl. M. Keechan of the City of Philadelphia in the
State of Pennsylvania in his own name and for his own use and benefit
to do and procure to be done all and singular these Acts matters and Things
which he the said Henry Purdy by force and Virtue of the said Letters
of Attorney or either of them might or could do or procure to be done
