Lancaster March 4th 1801

I certify that a patent has been made out in the name of James E. Moore, <sup>which is ready to be delivered to him</sup> for a Tract of two hundred acres of Donation Land, and Allowance of six per cent <sup>of</sup> the said Tract, in the sixth district of Donation Land, to which he is entitled for his services as a Soldier in the Pennsylvania Line, of the late Army of the United States, but that a claim was filed in October 1795, for the same land, by John Nicholson Esq<sup>r</sup>, since deceased, who at the time of filing the said claim, alleged that Moore had transferred the same to him - it therefore remains for the Board of Property to decide between Moore and the Representatives of W. Nicholson, under the Act of Assembly passed in the Month of February 1801.
