I, John Smith, of Baltimore County, in the State of Maryland, late a Soldier of the Sixth Pennsylvania Regiment Colonel Thomas have, and do hereby make, constitute and appoint James De Braufre, of the City of Philadelphia, and State of Pennsylvania my true and lawful Attorney for me and in my name and behalf, to my use, to

demand, and draw from the Agents or Persons appointed of the State of Pennsylvania the Donation Lands or the lands and Accruals of Pay due and belonging to me for my services as a Soldier in the Service of said State, or the United States of America, in the late War or Revolution between Great Britain and the United States of America; as well as all Documents thereto relating

with power also an Attorney or Attornies under me for the purpose aforesaid, to make and substitute, and to do and execute all lawful acts requisite for effecting the premises; as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do by being personally present, and to have done the same, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said Attorney or his substitute or substitutes shall do therein by virtue hereof.
