

Know all Men by these Presents, that I Lorenz Spiegel, Soldier
in the second Regiment of Pennsylvania, commanded by Colonel
Butler, in Capt. Pike's Company, in the service of the United
States of North America, and listed during the War, have made,
ordained, and constituted, and by these presents do make, ordain
and constitute, and in my place and stead put and depute
Joseph Levitz of Alleghenese Township, Northampton County
and State of Pennsylvania.

irrevocable for me, and in my name and stead, but to the
sole use of him, the said Joseph Levitz, his heirs and assigns
for ever, to ask demand, and by all lawful means recover
and receive all such sum or sums of Money, as well as grants
or confirmations, Lands and tenements, or other demands
whatsoever by the United States or the State of Pennsylvania
or any other person or persons acting under their authority,
and I also give and grant unto the said Joseph Levitz

power and absolute authority, to sell and dispose of all
and singular the Lands, tenements, gratuities and donations,
which I may be entitled to, or of right may claim, in virtue of
any act of the United States in Congress assembled or under the
authority of the State of Pennsylvania, for reason of my having
served in said Regiment, and Pennsylvania line, and by good
assurances in the Law, to grant and confirm to the purchasers
the fee simple and inheritance thereof, hereby granting unto
the said Joseph Levitz, his heirs and assigns, full power, sole
and exclusive authority, to execute and perform whatsoever
unders him or them, for the purpose aforesaid, ratifying whatsoever
my said Attornies shall do in the premises, by virtue hereof.
