rations gratuities or other demand due & owing to me
from the United States or from any particular state
for my services as aforesaid to have & to hold all singular
the above mentioned & assigns premises with the appur-
tenances unto him the said Christian Hubbert his
heirs & assigns for ever and do hereby nominate & appoint
him the said Christian Hubbert his heirs & assigns my
true & lawful Attorney in & capable to ask demand
recover & receive of & from the United States or from
any particular State or from any person or persons
acting by or under their or any of their authority
