in the Pennsylvania Line (For divers good Causes and
Considerations me herunto moving) have made, Ordained
Constituted and Appointed, and by these presents do make,
ordain Constitute and Appoint Robert Trull Esquire
of the County of Northampton aforesaid, my True &
Lawful Attorney, for me and in my Name to draw my
Lot for my Share of the Donation Lands to which I am intitled
as a Soldier as aforesaid - giving and granting to my
Said Attorney my sole and full power and Authority to fol-
low such legal Courses for the Recovery of the Same as I
myself might or could do were I personally Present; and
upon the Receipt of the Same Acquittances, and other suf-
ficient discharges, for me and in my name, to make sign
seal and deliver; and further to do perform and finish
for me and in my name, all singular thing or things
which shall or may be necessary to be done touching and
Concerning the Premises, as fully, thoroughly, and entirely
as the said John Spring in my own person might or
could do in and about the Same were I personally Present.
Ratifying, allowing and confirming, whatsoever my said
Attorney shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, in and
about the Execution of the Premises, by Virtue of these Presents.
