Know all men by these presents that I William Stewart
do hereby certify that the said P. William Stewart
was a Soldier in the late War, have named and purchased
and by these presents do name ordain and make Charles
Campbell Esq of Westmoreland County & State of Pennsylvania
and his full attorney for me and in my name and to my
heirs to demand due for the said P. Stewart in my
the full quantity of land due to me for my service done
to the United States while in their service and hereby
granting unto my said attorney my full power and authority
to use and exercise all such acts things and things
The law as shall be necessary for the recovering of the said
land and to make and give acquittance or other discharge
in my name and generally to do and execute in the
premises as fully as myself might or could do being
personally present halting confirming and allowing
Whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause
to be done therein by virtue of these presents

doe this 10th day of March 1795
