

Whereas the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by Letters Patent bearing date the second day of March 1831 One thousand Eight hundred & three did grant unto Elias Ott private in the late Army of the United States a certain tract of land called "Hunters choice" Numbered 299 in Donations district No 2. in Butler County Beginning at a Black oak thence by No 298 West Two hundred Sixty one perches to a Black Oak, thence by No 316 South One hundred & thirty perches to a White Oak, thence by No 318 East Two hundred Sixty one perches to a Black Oak, & thence by No 292 North One hundred & thirty perches to the Beginning containing Two hundred acres and allowance &c as in & by said patent enrolled in patent book No 48 Pa 399 may more fully appear. And whereas for a valuable consideration the said Elias Ott did by his deed bearing date the third day of March 1831 One thousand Eight hundred & three sell and convey the said Lot No 299 as above described unto Jacob Froese of Strasburg in fee as in and by said deed recorded in the office for recording deeds in & for Butler County in Book A page 81 will more fully appear By Force & Virtue of which said recited indenture and of other good conveyances in the law duly had & executed the said Jacob Froese became in his lifetime lawfully seized in his demise as of fee of and in the said Lot No 299 and its appurtenances as above described containing Two hundred acres and allowance, and being so thereof seized did leaving by his last will & testament duly proven and recorded the said Lot No 299 as above described in
