

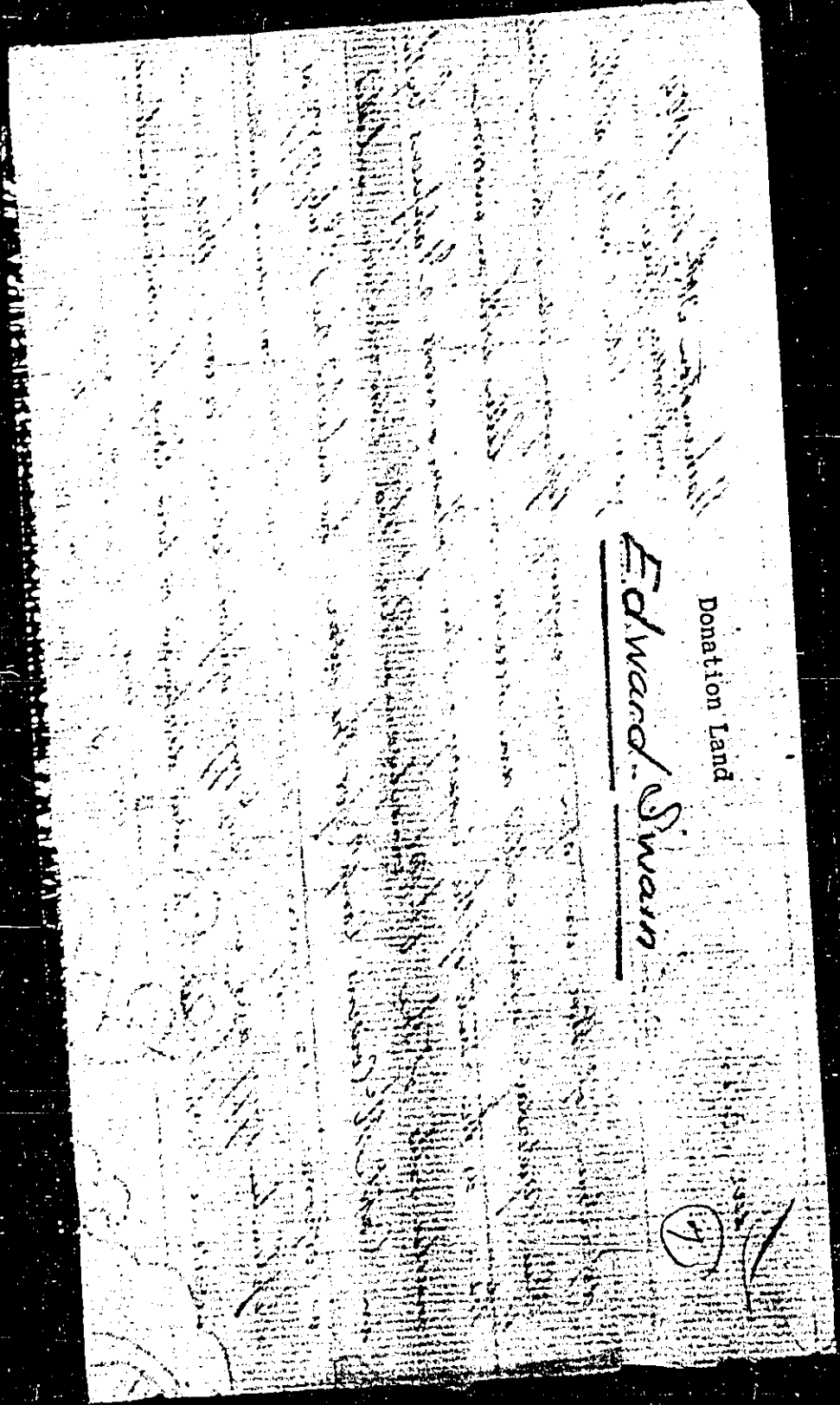

On the 17th June 1804 before me

Walter Edge one of the Justices of the Peace in and for the County aforesaid came Mary Maddox who being sworn upon the holy Evangelists of Almighty God testifies and says that she then dependent was lawfully joined in Holy Wedlock with Edward Swain (formerly a Sergeant in the Invalians) by the Reverend William Allison in the year 1770 on the 8th April, that she had by the said Sergeant Swain Six Children five of whom are dead and that one is still living a Daughter who was Twenty four years of age on the 14th May last past which Daughter is deprived of her sight and this dependent doth further say that she was taken Prisoner with her husband Edward Swain by the British at Fort Mifflin in the year 1776 that she then was robbed of her Certificate of Marriage and the Reverend Mr Allison being dead she cannot obtain a Marriage Certificate at this time
