


Know all men by these presents that I Thomas West of the County of York, Late a Soldier in the 2^d Pennsylvania Regt, (for Divis Consideration and good Cause me hereunto moving) have made, Ordained, Constituted, and appointed, and by these presents do make, Ordain, Constitute, & appoint, the Hon^{ble} Jonathan Hoge Esquire, one of the members of the Supreme Executive Council of the State of Pennsylvania, my true & Lawfull Attorney for me, in my name, & to my use, to Draw my lot of land, in the Lottery of the Donation lands Given by the State of Pennsylvania, to the Officers and Soldiers of their Line, for Services, ^{Done} During the late war, Giving, and by these presents granting, to my said Attorney, My sole and full power and authority, to take, pursue, and follow, such legal Courses, for securing the same for my use, as I my self might or could do were I personally present and further to do perform and finish for me & in my name, all and singular thing, or things, which shall or may be necessary touching & concerning the premises, as fully, thoroughly & entirely, as I the said Thomas West in my own person ought or could do in and about the same, Ratifying, allowing, and Confirming, whatsoever my said Attorney shall Lawfully do or Cause to be done in & about the execution of the premises, by virtue of these presents.
