This Indenture made and concluded
the twenty fourth day of February Anno Domini
1787 Between William Willis a Serjeant in the
late Army of the United States of the one Part and
Francis Murray of the County of Bucks in the
State of Pennsylvania Esquire of the other
Part Witnesseth that the said William Willis
for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty
Pounds to him in hand paid by the said Francis
Murray and for other valuable Considerations
Worth by these presents grant bargain sell release
and confirm unto the said Francis Murray his
Heirs and Assigns for ever A certain tract of
Land in one of the Donation Districts in the County
of Westmoreland containing Two hundred and
fifty Acres and Allowance of 1/2^d in District N. 6
and Lot N. 1255 and I do desire that the Patent
may give in my Name and as the property of the
said Francis Murray his Heirs and Assigns for
ever and I do by these presents warrant and
Defend it from me my Heirs and Assigns for ever
and from all and every other person and persons
whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim by from
or under me. In Witness whereof the said Parties
have hereunto interchangeably set their Hands
and Seals Dated the day and year above Written.
