

Abraham Nelson of Garrard County in the State of Kentucky
stated in his Petition to the Governor, that he had served several
months under Gen. Washington, and nearly 5 Years under Gen.
Clark, during last War, that at this time he had the painful
misfortune of having two sons killed by the Indians and himself
taken prisoner, that he remained a captive 18 Months and
then made his escape; that on his return home, he found his
house burned and his wife dead from the effect of her Misfor-
tune; and therefore prayed his excellency to take his case into
consideration, and put him in some way to obtain his part
of the Donation lands promised by the State. —
