giving and granting unto our said Attorney, by these Presents, our full and whole Powers, Strength, and Authority, in and about the Premises, to have, use and take, all lawful Ways and Means in our Name for the Recovery thereof; and upon the Receipt of any such Debts, Dues, or Sums of Money aforesaid, Acquittances, or other sufficient Discharges, for us and in our Name, to make, seal and deliver; and generally all and every other Act and Acts, Thing and Things, Device or Devices, in the Law whatsoever, needful and necessary to be done in and about the Premises, for us and in our Name, to do, execute and perform, as fully, largely and amply, to all Intents and Purposes, as we might or could do, if we were personally present, or as if the Matter required more special Authority than is herein given; and Attorneys one or more under him for the Purpose aforesaid, to make and constitute, and again at Pleasure to revoke; ratifying, allowing and holding, for firm and effectual, all and whatsoever our said attorney shall lawfully do in and about the Premises, by Virtue hereof.
