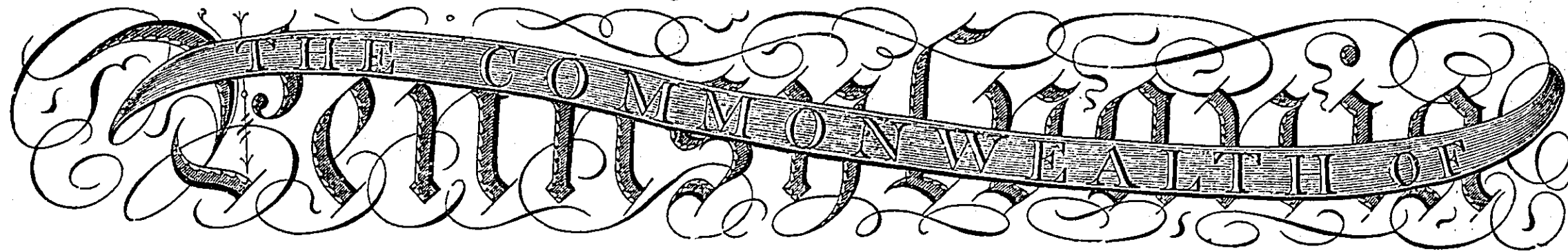


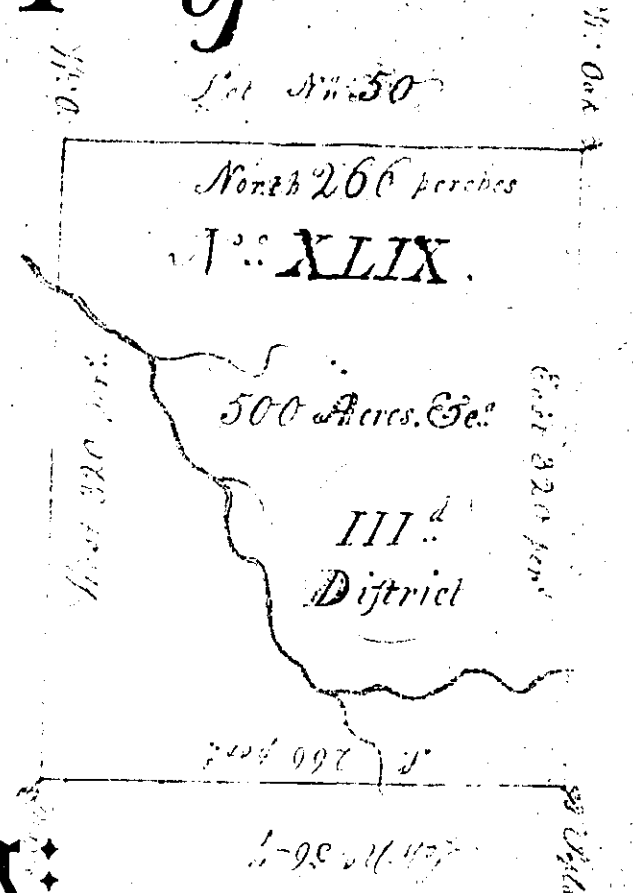
In the NAME and by the AUTHORITY of

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:



Whereas in consideration of the services rendered by Daniel Bredhead in the late Army of the United States, he the said Daniel Bredhead was possessed of a Patent, granting unto him in the name of the Commonwealth a certain Tract of Land in that part of the tenth district of Donation Land which is found to lie within the boundaries of the State of New-York.

Know ye, That in consideration of the surrender of the said Patent, and of a Release or Quit-claim executed by the said Daniel Bredhead unto the Commonwealth for any compensation he the said Daniel Bredhead might be entitled to on account of his loss by reason of the premises, there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto the said Daniel Bredhead his Heirs and Assigns, all that certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying in the county of ... BEGINNING at a white oak tree ...

To have and to hold the said Tract or Parcel of Land with its appurtenances unto the said Daniel Bredhead his Heirs and Assigns, to the only proper use, benefit, and advantage of the said Daniel Bredhead his Heirs and Assigns for ever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations, as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving the part of all gold and silver ore, for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. In Testimony whereof I have set my Hand, and caused the great Seal of the Commonwealth to be affixed to these Presents, at Philadelphia, this twenty seventh day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety-four, and of the Commonwealth the thirtieth.
