

The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING :

KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Robert Campbell's private* in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto *the said Robert Campbell*

a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the county of *Wilmoretland*

In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a Beech Tree the numbered corner and running East by Vacant Land two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree, thence South by Lot No 2147 one hundred and thirty perches to a Sugar Tree, thence West by Lot No 2145 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree, thence North by Lot No 2149 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning containing Two hundred Acres and allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads

The Number **UNO MILI** with its appurtenances, unto the said *Robert Campbell* his heirs and assigns forever :

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Robert Campbell* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

Robert Campbell his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle*

Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the State seal to be affixed the *tenth* day of *August* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty *seven* and of the commonwealth the *twelfth*
