KNOW YE, That in consideration of the services rendered by *John*  
*Plain private* \_\_\_\_\_ in the army of the *State of Pennsylvania*  
there is granted by the said commonwealth unto *the said John Plain* \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_ a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland in  
*the first District of the Donation Lands Beginning at a post and White Oak the numbered corner and*  
*running south by Lot No 155 One hundred and thirty perches to a post and Hickory tree, thence East by Lot No 166*  
*Two hundred and sixty one perches to a post and Asp tree, thence North by Lot No 178 One hundred and thirty*  
*perches to an Ironwood tree, thence West by Lot No 166 Two hundred and sixty one perches to the place of bearing*  
*run containing Two \_\_\_\_\_ and allowance of six perches for roads as numbered CLXXII*

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said  
*John Plain his* \_\_\_\_\_ heirs and assigns forever *To the only proper use and behoof of the said*  
*John Plain his Heirs and Assigns forever* \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_ free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth

the state seal to be affixed the *eleventh* day of *June* \_\_\_\_\_ in the year of our Lord one
