To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Job Riley Soldier* in the late army of the United States there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *Job Riley* a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland* in the tenth District of Donation Lands, Beginning at a Maple the numbered corner running East by Sol N^o 2142 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech, thence South by Sol N^o 2152 One hundred thirty perches to a Beech, thence West by Sol N^o 2140 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar, thence North by Sol N^o 2124 One hundred thirty perches to the place of Beginning containing Two hundred Acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Numbered M M C X L I

with its appurtenances unto the said *Job Riley* his heirs and assigns forever: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Job Riley* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said *Job Riley* his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle* Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the state seal to be affixed the *fourteenth* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty *six* and of the commonwealth the *seventh*
