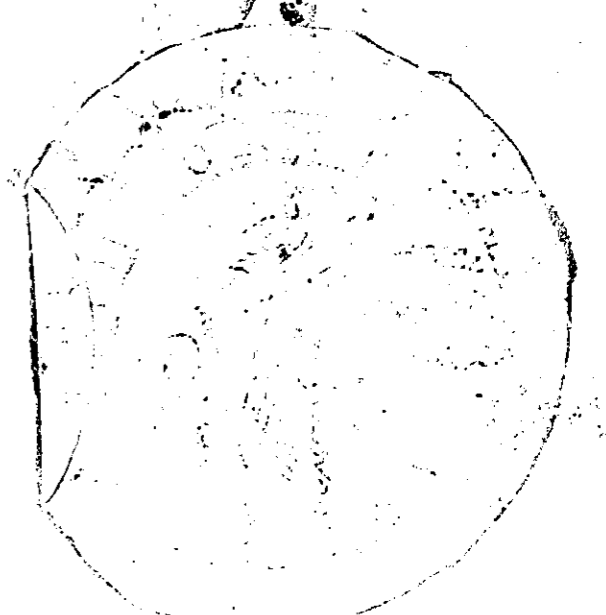

 to have and to hold the same to the said Samuel George his heirs  
 and assigns to his heirs and assigns forever with power unto them  
 whosoever my hand and seal this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January 1788  
 sealed & delivered in presence of  
 Henry Williams Thomas ...  
 Edward Stephens Esquire of the County of ...  
 in and for the City and County of Philadelphia  
 named William Barquett and acknowledged the within written  
 Instrument to be his act and deed and saying the same to be  
 recorded as such.
