



The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by *John Spalding* in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto *Stephen Loudon* Assignee of the said *John Spalding* a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland* in the *Tenth* district of donation Lands beginning at an *Ash Tree* the *Numbered* Corner and running East by *Lot N^o 2149* two hundred and *Sixty one* perches, to a *Sugar Tree*, thence South by *Lot N^o 2000* one hundred and *thirty* perches to a *Sugar Tree*, thence West by *Lot N^o 2151* two hundred and *Sixty one* perches to a *Beech Tree*, thence North by *Lot N^o 2149* one hundred and *thirty* perches to the place of beginning containing *Two Hundred Acres*, allowance of *Six p^{ts} Cent* for *Roads &c* Numbered *MMCL*.

with its appurtenances unto the said *Stephen Loudon* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Stephen Loudon* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

Stephen Loudon his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges.
