To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by *John Williams* in the late army of the *United States*

Williams Drummer there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *John Williams*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*
*In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a Birch Tree the numbered corner and running East by Lot N^o. 2121 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree thence South by Lot N^o. 2115 one hundred and thirty perches to a Birch Tree thence West by Lot N^o. 2123 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar Tree, thence North by Lot N^o. 2115 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning Containing Two hundred Acres and allowance of Six Cent for Roads by ^{no} Numbered *MCCXXII**

with its appurtenances unto the said *John Williams* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John Williams* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

John Williams his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth

Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the state seal to be affixed the *twenty third* day of *December* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty *six* and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
