van Campen of Lower Smithfield County and State aforesaid Gent: my
true and lawful Attorney for me and in my Name and to my Use apply
for, ask, recover or receive a Title and Patent for five Hundred Acres
of Donation Land agreeable to Act of Assembly due to me as Capt.
of a Company of Pennsylvania Rangers. — I do further empower
my said Attorney by Virtue of the Power vested in me to apply for,
recover and receive Titles and Patents for Donation Lands
for the following Persons late Soldiers of my said Company
viz. Daniel St. Clair, Frederic Shoop, Leonard Yager,
John Zacharias and Jacob Hopple: Giving and by these Presents
granting to my said Attorney my sole and full Power and Authority to
take, pursue and follow such legal Courses, for the Recovery, receiv-
ing and obtaining of the same as myself might or could do, were
I personally present: And upon the Receipt of the same Acquit-
ances and other sufficient Discharges for me and in my Name
to make, sign, seal and deliver.
