



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing Date the 16th Day of January Anno Dom 1737 I have surveyed and Laid out unto John Harris in the Township of Pennsborough in the County of Lancaster on the West side Susquehanna River Eight hundred & Twenty Acres of Land with allowance of Six p cent Beginning at a post by Susquehanna River Thence South Twenty Degrees Westerly by Land of Aaron Price Two hundred and two pches to a post Thence North Seventy five Degrees Westerly One hundred & Twenty pches to a black oak Thence North Sixty two Degrees Westerly forty pches to a post Thence North forty Degrees Westerly One hundred and twenty pches to a Hickery Thence North Sixty five Degrees Westerly One hundred & Twenty Eight pches to a White-Oak Thence North Twenty Degrees Easterly by Land of David Priest four hundred and two pches to the ^{place of Beginning} _{of said River thence down by the same 516 pches}
