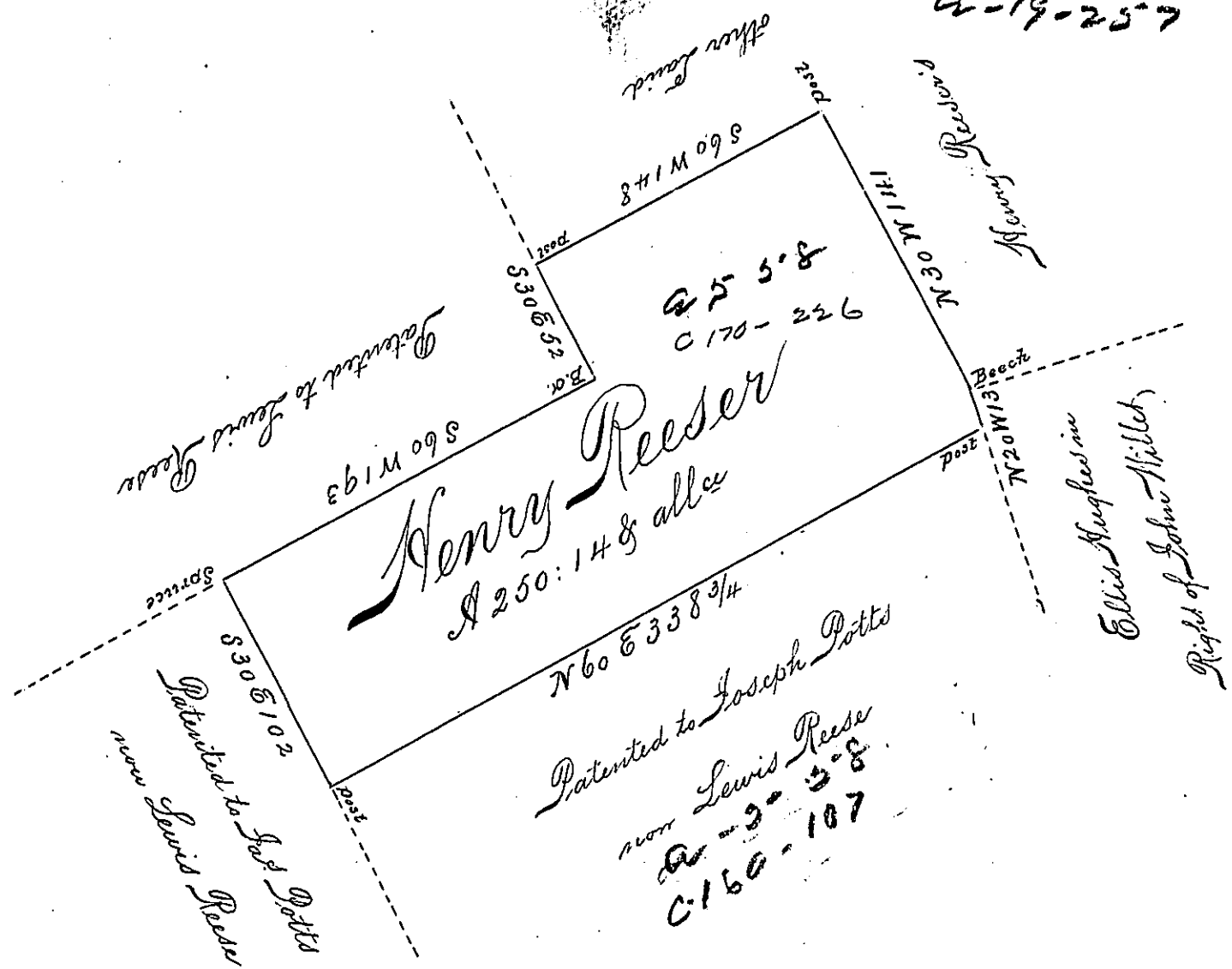

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the ninth day of May A.D. 1793 Granted to Henry Reeser, Resurvey'd to him the above described Tract or piece of Land, Situate in (late Manheim) now Norweigen Township Berks County, Containing Two hundred & fifty Acres, Fourteen perches & usual allow<sup>ce</sup> of 6 pCent for Roads &c

N.B. The above named Warrant was Executed by William Wheeler late Dep. Sur. for the said Henry Reeser, Not on the same spot but adjoining the above and along the line N 60 E 338 3/4 ps and contained A 279:63 & allee as by the return filed in the Surveyor General's dated May 28. 1793 will appear on which said Tract of A 279:63 was also a Survey made on Application N<sup>o</sup> 3139 dated March 2<sup>d</sup> 1768 Granted to Charles Robison and contained A 261:139 allee for which since a Patent was Granted to Joseph Potts, bearing date Feb 23. 1797.
