



Situate on the west side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 Acres 150 perches & allowance of 6 per cent for roads Resurveyed the 13th July 1799 In pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres granted to David Evans bearing date the 30th May 1792 It being the same tract of land which was surveyed 6th November 1794 for John Jones on his improvement dated 5th Nov^r 1794 Crawford County S.S.

I do Certify the above is a true Copy of Survey as it stands Stated of Record Remaining in my office now situate in Tullomfield township Crawford County Excepting the Line of division which was surveyed and marked between Arthur Dillon & Joseph Clark the 14th day of July 1817 To Rich^d. J. Leech Surveyor General. James Herrington
