



A Draught of a tract of land containing one hundred and ninety five acres and one hundred and thirty perches and allowance of six per cent for roads situate on the west side of the Susquehanna River and adjoining the same near three miles below the mouth of Wyox Creek in the Township of Towanda County of Bradford And is as appears from the Traverse of the said River and other Circumstances the remainder of a tract of land surveyed to Mary Bracken in pursuance of a warrant dated in the year 1784 not included in a survey made in pursuance of a Warrant of a earlier date in the Name of Sarah Morrison Resurveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> day of September 1812 in pursuance of an order from the Board of property dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of September 1811
