



A Draught of a Tract of land called *situate on Rearing Creek adjoining*  
 and above land surveyed for Situs Neatlack about Eighteen Miles above Fort Lu-  
 gusta in the County of Northumberland containing Two hundred and ninety eight  
 Acres & one hundred and Eight perches besides the usual allowance of 6 Cent  
 for Roads &c. surveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 1773 for Sam<sup>l</sup> Shakespeare in pur-  
 suance of a Warrant dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of Decem<sup>r</sup> 1772.
