Resurveyed 2<sup>d</sup> October 1828 and found to lie within the Lines of a larger Tract of 163 1/4<sup>ac</sup> Surveyed 18 May 1767 on an Order to John Jack dated 4<sup>th</sup> February 1767 No<sup>o</sup> 2683, and a Patent produced Granted to Dan Huston dated 25 April 1806 founded on the last mentioned Order and Survey.
