



The above is the draught of a survey made March 24<sup>th</sup> 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Edmund Randolph on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the waters of Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to William Realston Esquire called Bethmold containing 400 acres with the usual allowance of 6 per Cent be-
