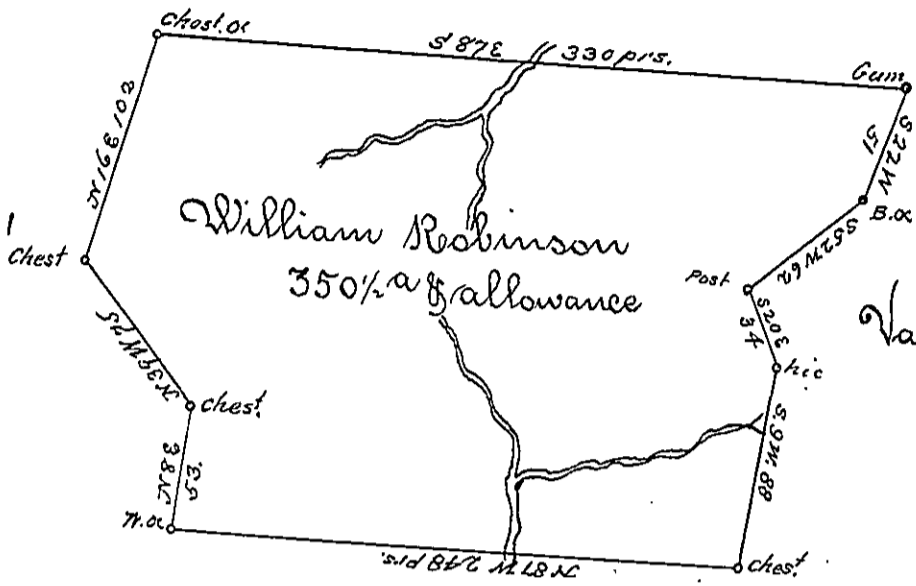

By Warrant of the 13<sup>th</sup> of December 1723 -
