



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 29th April 1822 Surveyed the 20th March 1824 (by George Palmer) to George & A. Gano the above described tract of land situate on the head waters of Beaver pond Creek a middle branch of Quakake Limestone Township Northampton County containing three hundred and twenty acres eighteen perches and the allowance of six feet per acre. Examined and approved the 13th July 1825.
