By Warrant dated the 6th day of December 1831. which includes the mouth of Spring (oil) In the last purchase made of the Indians, East of (oil) Allegheny River and Conawango Creek in Ridgeway Township in the County of Jefferson. By Warrant dated the 5th day of March A. D. 1793. No. 3736.
