



Situate in Liverpool Township Perry County and contains sixteen acres one hundred & forty four perches & Allowance of six per Cent for roads &c. Originally surveyed November 4th 1816. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Frederick Rinehart for 60^{ac} dated October 3rd 1816 which was returned 61^{ac} 47^{sq} p. & Allowance. And now March 24th 1830 Resurveyed and corrected as above for Frederick Rinehart to patent
