



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Maxatawny Township, now in the County of Berks, but formerly in the County of Philadelphia, in the Province of Pennsylvania. Being the equal half part of a Tract of 300 Acres. That in Pursuance of a Warrant from the Honble. The Proprietaries dated the 23^d Day of August Anno 1735, was Surveyed unto George Bost (al Gerrick's Tract) who sold his Right to the above part thereof unto Jacob Miller, and the Same was accordingly divided and Surveyed to him. In whom also the Right to the Same was Vested. on the 3^d December Anno 1744. The said Jacob Miller afterwards sold his Right to the same unto Casper Wink and Redgain to Michael Christman. formerly Surveyed and Divided by Edward Scull Surveyor Resurveyed on the 5th Day of May Anno 1763.
