By Order of the Surveyor General, And at the request of Captain ~~James~~ Harry Gordon, Assisted by Major James Livingstone and Captain Lemuel Barrett, Who showed the land to me. I did on the Tenth Day of June 1766 Survey for James Dow the above described Tract of Land Situate on Curtis Creek on the North West side of the Ragged Mountain & Adjoining Thomas Barnsleys Land in Cumberland County containing nine Hundred & Fifty Seven Acres; And the usual Allowance of six Per Cent for Roads.
