



Surveyed on the seventeenth day of July 1734 to Moses Starr a certain tract of Land Situate <sup>near</sup> a Branch of the River Skunkell called Sun denheles in the County of Philad.<sup>a</sup> Beginning at a post a Corner of Isaac Starr's land <sup>by Vacant</sup> thence South East One hundred and Seventy perches to a post thence by <sup>South West one hundred & fifty perches to a post thence by land</sup> Vacant land laid out for Mary Hockley South West One hundred and Seventy perches to a post in the line of Isaac Starr's land thence by the same North East one hundred and fifty perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty Acres with usual allowance.
