



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries, dated the fifth day of March 1734. Surveyed unto Conrade Gehr a Tract of Land Situate in Sulford Township in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Beginning at a post a Corner of a Tract laid out for Nicholas Uplinger thence by the same North West Two hundred and twenty-two perches to a post, thence by s<sup>d</sup> Uplinger's Land South West twenty six perches & a half perch to a White Oak, thence by land of s<sup>d</sup> Conrade Gehr South East two hundred twenty two perches to a Hickory thence by land of Casper Wister North East Twenty six perches & a half perch to y<sup>e</sup> place of Beginning, Containing Thirty four acres and a half acre with the usual allowance of six sq. Cent
