



A Draught of a Tract of Land, called Spring Grove, Situate on the Waters of Beaver Meadow Run; about a mile to the Northward of that part of the Old Road, leading from Bedford to Fort Pitt, where it crosses the said Run, adjoining Land of Stephen Carmack, Joseph Mather and Frederick Hagner in Cumberland County Containing three hundred and thirty-six acres and the usual allowance of six p. Cent for Roads, Surveyed the 20th Day of September 1770 for Samuel Taylor of the City and County of Philadelphia by Virtue of a Warrant granted to him the 2^d Day of July in the year aforesaid
