



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property Bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following on a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Twenty five for James Grinding containing in Breadth East and West on Shamokin Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Shamokin Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number Twenty six, Southward by Barberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Twenty four
