



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Walnut Bottom situate on Stony Creek including the Mouth of Jamesons Breast Work Run about a Mile & an half below where the Great Road from Bedford to Fort Pitt crosses said Creek in Brothers Valley Township in the County of Bedford containing two hundred and twenty Acres and the usual Allowance of six p Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1770 for Thomas Wood in pursuance of an Order N<sup>o</sup> 2953 Dated April 7<sup>th</sup> 1769 by
