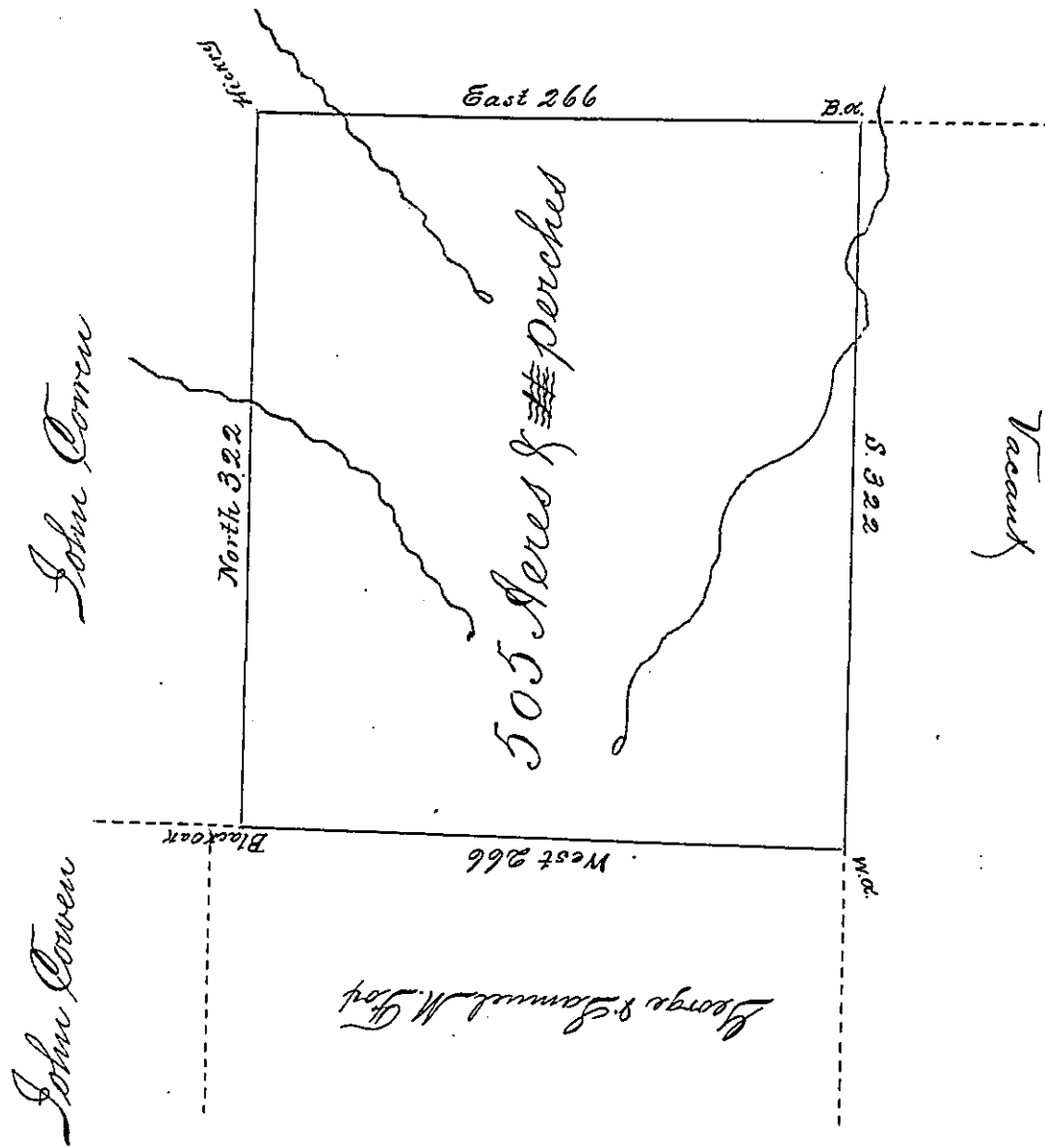


Dickinson College Land



Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1786 for George and Samuel M. Ford the above Described Tract of land containing five Hundred and five Acres and four perches with the Usual Allowance of Six p<sup>ts</sup> etc. Situated and lying on the North side of Tobys Creek and on the East side of Allegheny River about Ten Miles from said Creek and adjoining Lands Surveyed to the Trustees of Dickinson College and John Cowen in pursuance of a warrant Granted them the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785 late purchase Northumberland County No 222
