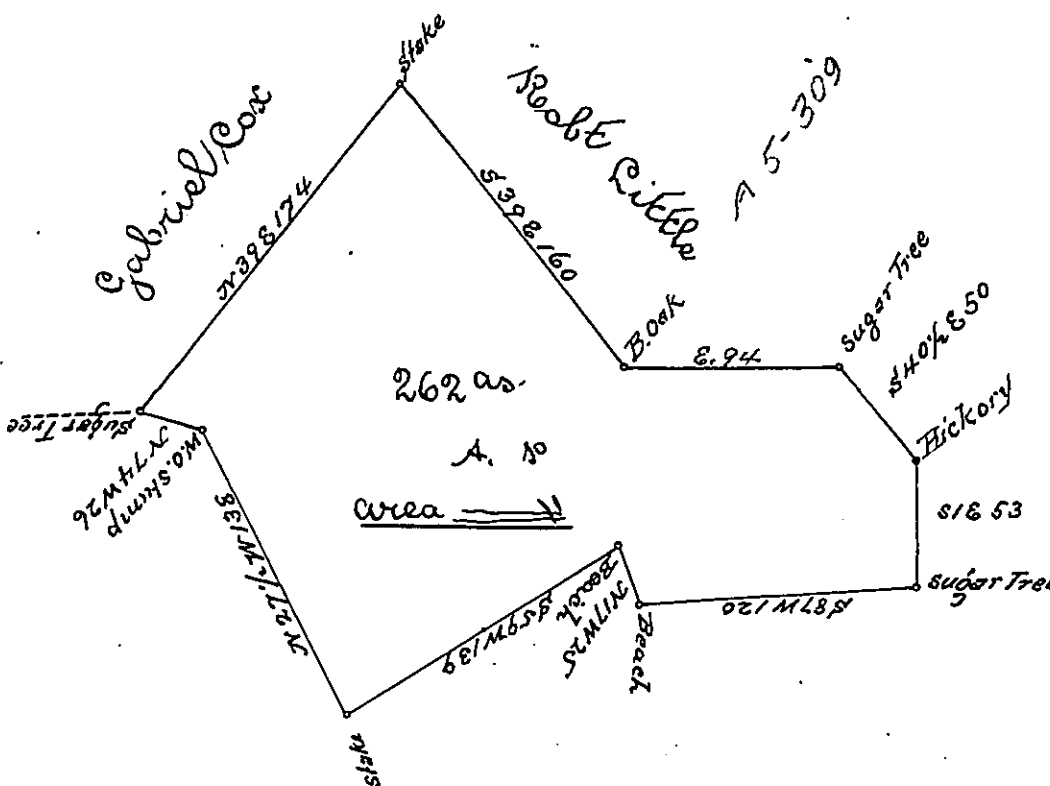


N.B. the Certif. entered the 18th Febr^y 1780. E.S.



The above is a Draught of a Survey made for Gabriel Cox in pursuance of a Certificate granted him in the following words We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Youghagania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Gabriel Cox is entitled to four Hundred acres of Land in Yohogania County on the waters of Monong^a to include his actual settlement made in the year one thousand seven Hundred and sixty nine also a right in pre-emption to one thousand acres adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Coxes Fort the twenty fifth day of January 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
