Tooke. The above survey made in Pursuance of an order from the Honorable Board of Property of Pennsylv^a as well as a warrant the order Dated the 2th Day of September 1801.

Report of the commencement and continuance of any improvement in the place thus mark'd # there appears as there was a cabin intended to be erected. It appears as if there was no roof on it the door cut out no chimney built no clear land about it No person in that neighbourhood could exactly remember the time it was built but it to be built by one Daniel Thompson tho he never lived in it. The part included within the dotted lines shows ^{the} land

cleared by John Ramsay before the making of his survey & remains to be cultivated by him yet
