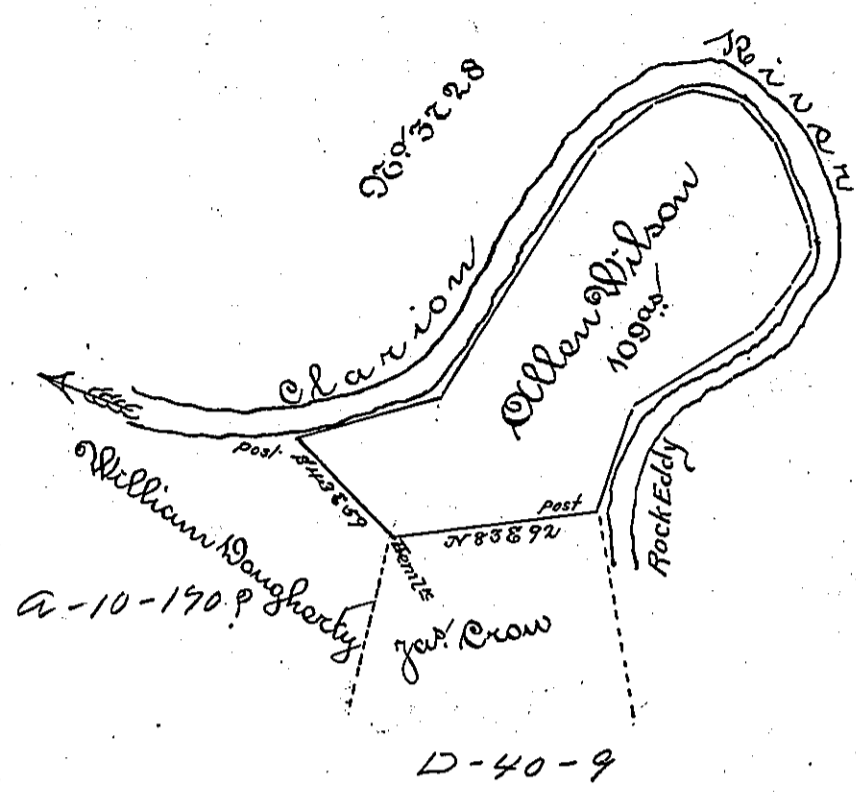


The Course and Distance

ed tract of land containing one hundred and nine acres and allowance  
of six per cent for roads be situate on the south side of the Clarion Riv-  
er in the last purchase made of the Indians East of the Allegheny River  
and Conawango Creek in Ridgway Township in the County of Jefferson  
By virtue of a Warrant granted to Allen Wilson for 100<sup>acs</sup> dated at Har-  
risburg the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1836
