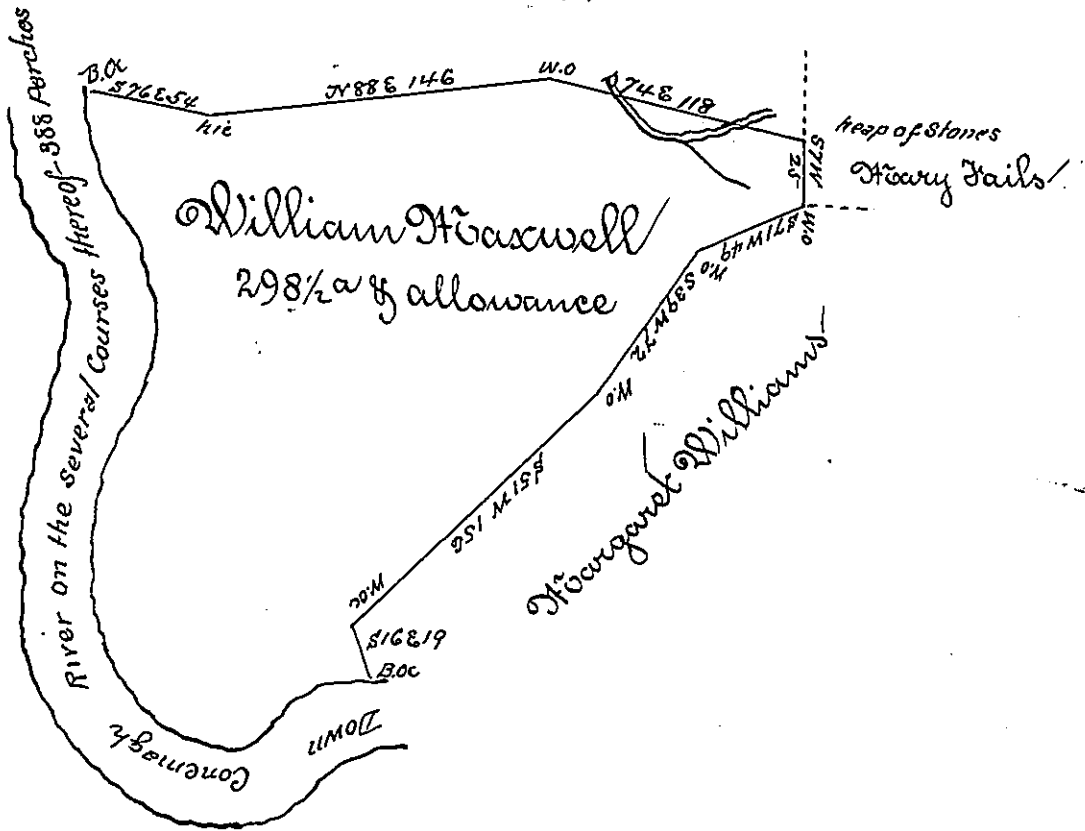


Charles Campbell
