Acres & 54 perches & the allow^{ce} &c in pursuance of an Application N^o 606 Granted To Matthew Atkinson the 24th day of November 1767. - May the 7th 1803 - Pursuant to an Order of the Board of Property in favor of George Patterson Resurvey'd the above Tract Bearing date the 31st day of January 1803 - Resurvey'd the above Tract which appears to contain 281.79^a &c making an addition thereto of 19^a & 94 perches - Including in the whole Three hundred and one acres and 13 perches and the allowance of Six p^{er} Cent for Roads &c
