Waters of the Standing Stone Creek in Parrice Town-
ship Huntingdon County containing 225.108 ^{a.}_{Rs.} and the
usual Allowance for Roads Surveyed the 16th day of
November 1791 In pursuance of a Warrant dated the
2^d day of October 1776

Wm. McCays when in his District the Field Notes
of which I have examined & find to be accurate Sam-
uel Porter who now lives on it says he has an Old War-
rant for it and claims it.
