



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Hickory Level situated adjoining and North East of the old Trading Path leading from Frankstown to the Kittanning about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a Mile N.W. from the Chest. Spring adjoining Lands surveyed for Alexander Stuart William Hodges, Richard Finney and others ^{on both sides of the Chest Run} in the County of Bedford containing three hundred and thirteen Acres and an half Acre and the usual Allowance of six P. Cent for Roads &c.
