



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the 6th day of August 1844 was surveyed the 3^d day of December 1844 for Edward Fitz Randolph the above described tract of land, containing four hundred three acres one hundred twenty four perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Adams Township Crawford County including part of Lincolns run about two Miles west of Meadville and at the time of making said survey the said Edward Fitz Randolph was actually living on the same with his family and it appeared that he had cleared fenced and cultivated upwards of thirty acres of the land.
